INTRODUCTION

The programme is designed for ethic-minority secondary school students aged 11-15 who attended school on an irregular basis. During this short-term training, participants will experience into five core services which are Adventure Training, Skills Training, Dream Programmes, Parents Services and Alumni Club.

AIMS OF THE PROGRAMME

To equip participants with a range of skills, assist them in setting up personal goals, improve their social skills, enhance their self-understanding and self-efficacy and to prepare them for challenges in their life planning by providing them with opportunities to engage in a range of constructive activities.
